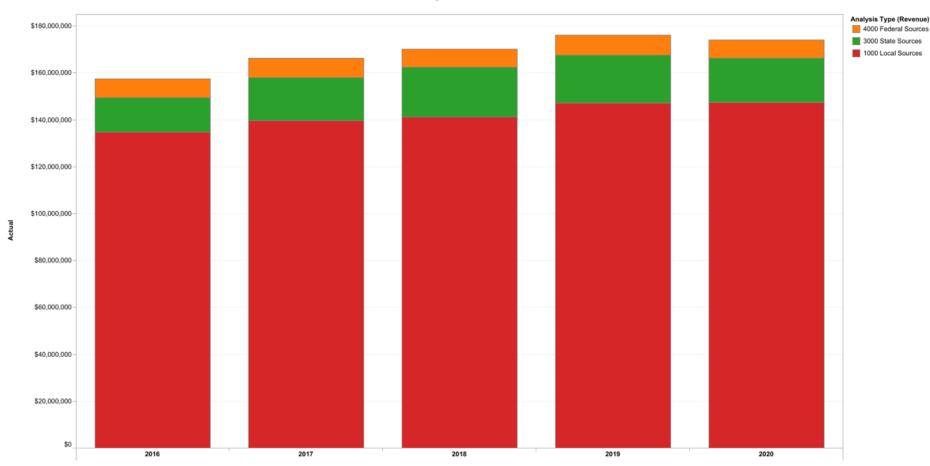

CUSD 200 By: Source Source: 5 Year Budget and AFR

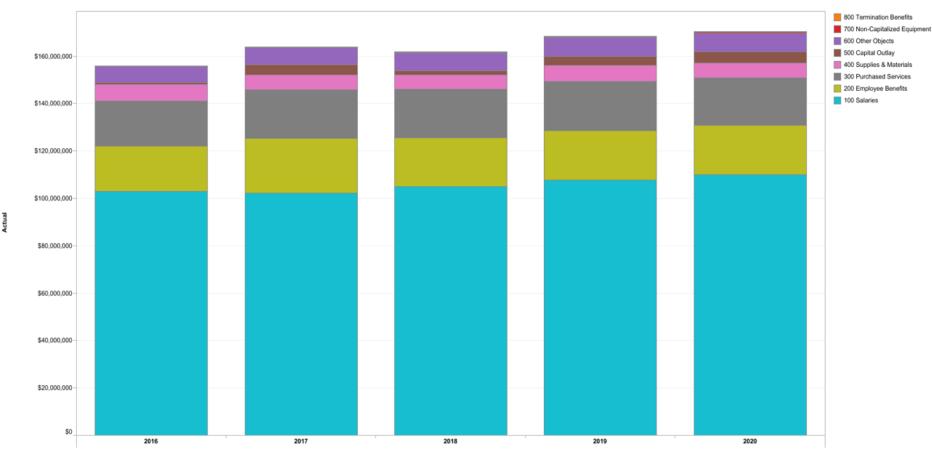




Operational Expenses (FY2016-2020)

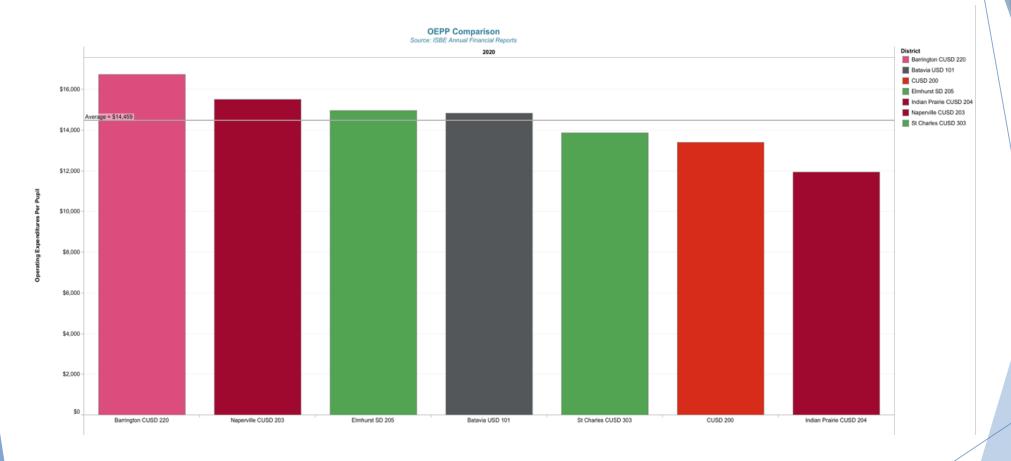
Expenses Bar Chart

Operating Expense Per Pupil (FY2020)

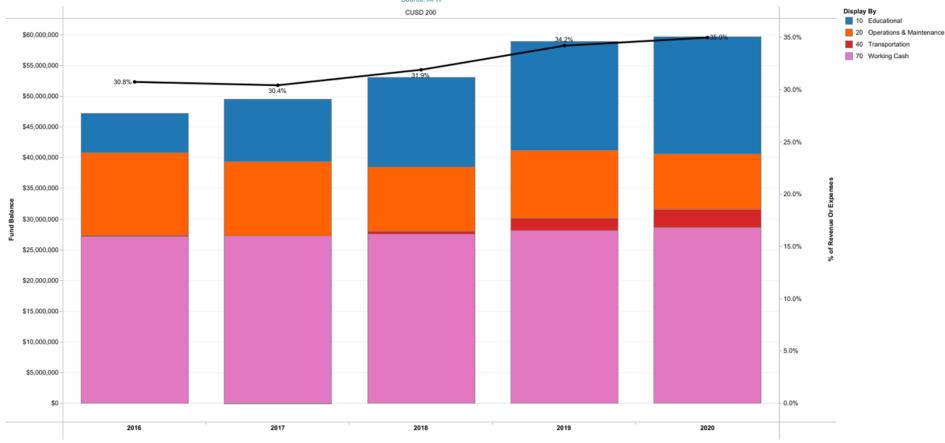




Fund Balance History (FY2016-2020)

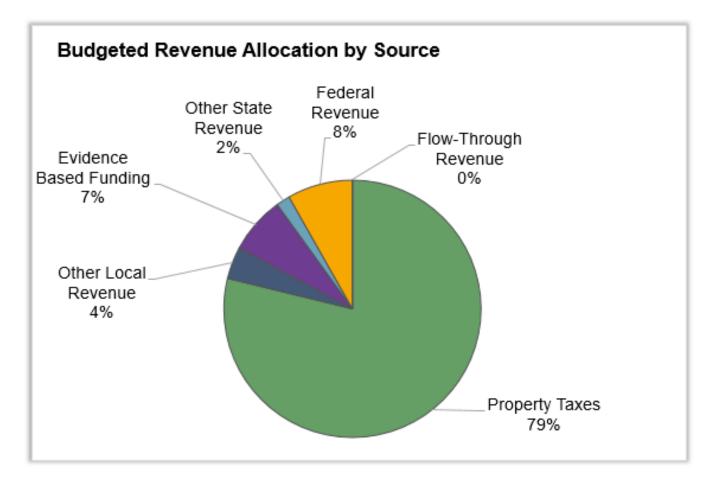

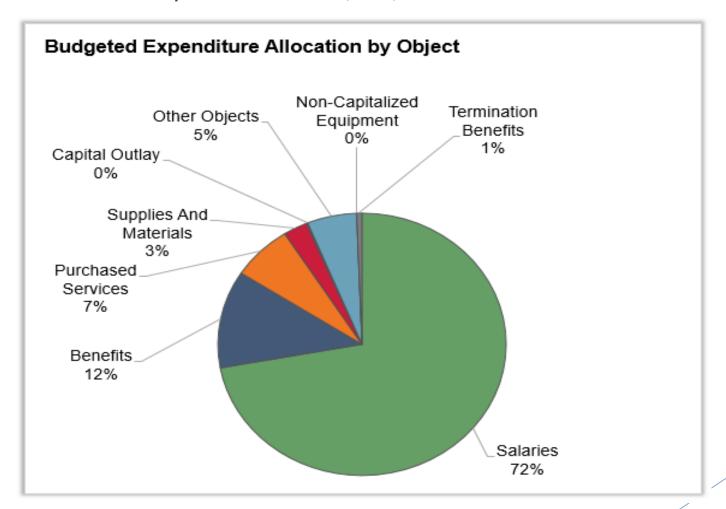


► Education Fund - Revenues \$154,536,948



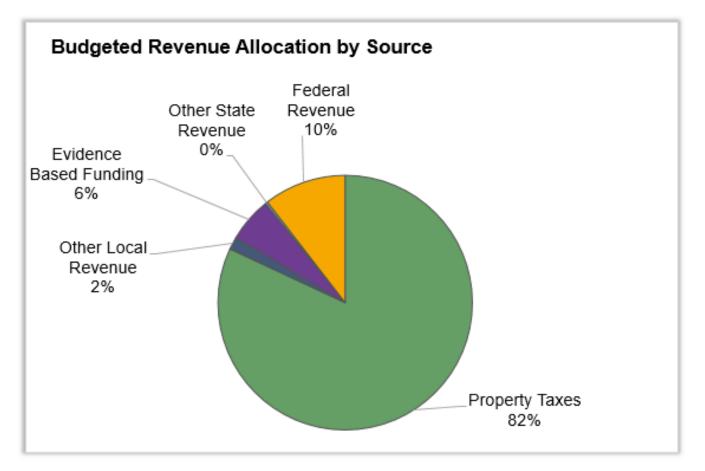


► Education Fund - Expenditures \$154,536,594



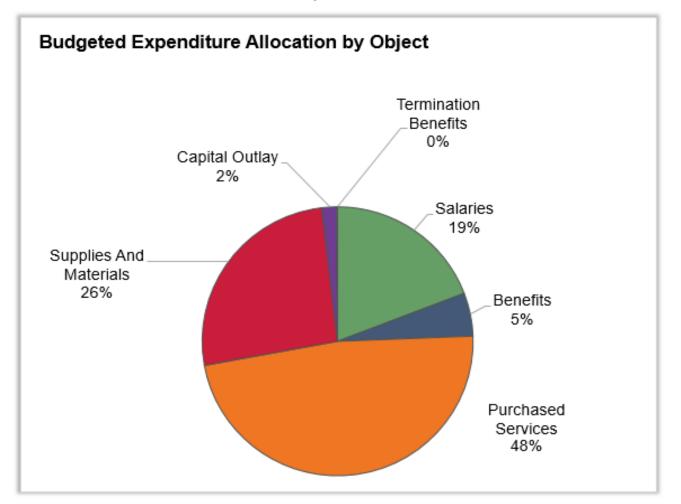


▶ Operations & Maintenance - Revenue \$18,394,622



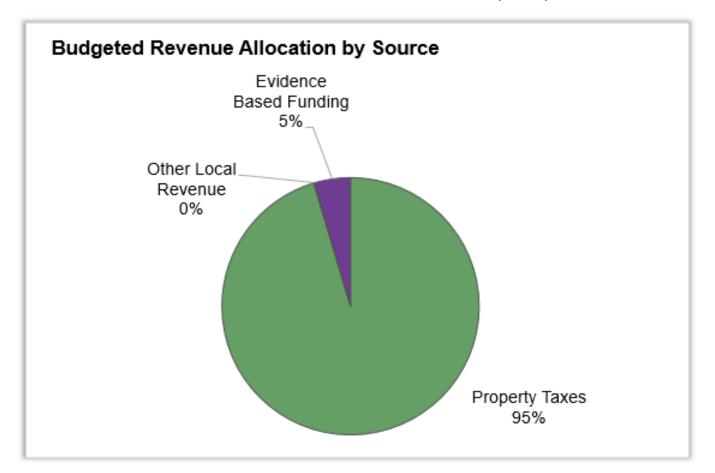


▶ Operations & Maintenance - Expenditures \$11,193,584



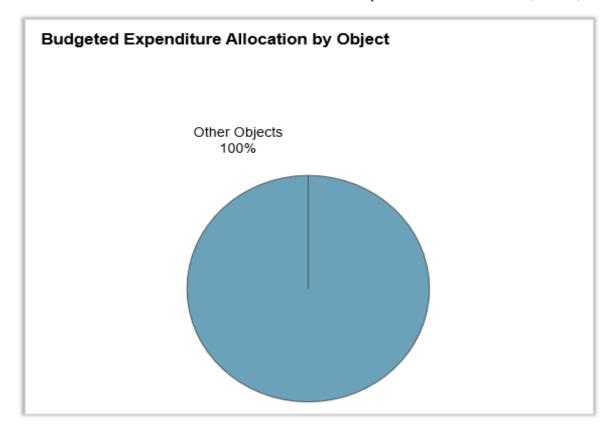


▶ Debt Services - Bond & Interest - Revenue \$20,835,238



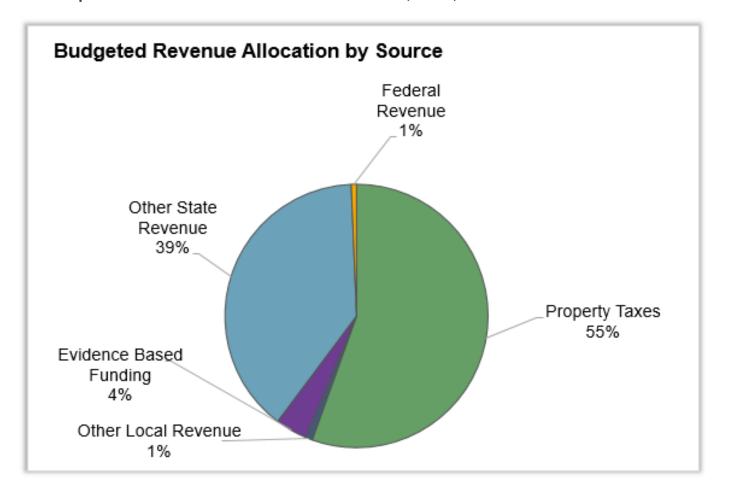


▶ Debt Services - Bond & Interest - Expenditures \$21,690,326



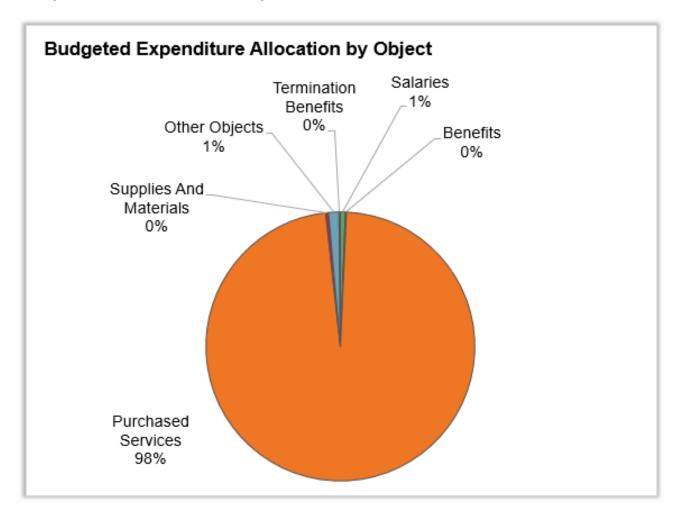


Transportation Fund - Revenues \$10,222,602



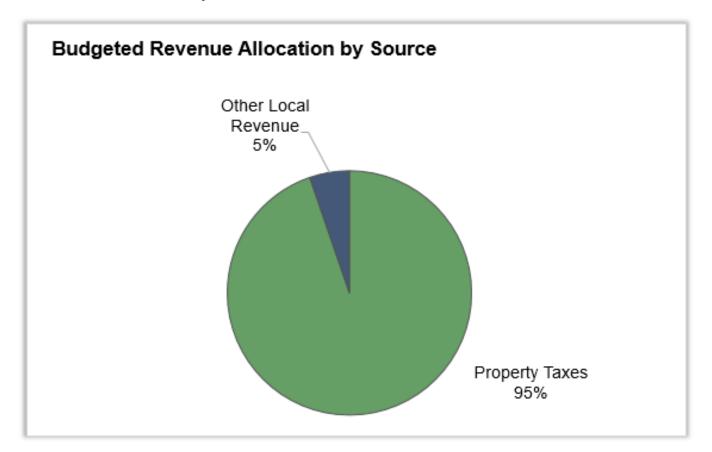


Transportation Fund - Expenditures \$10,206,625



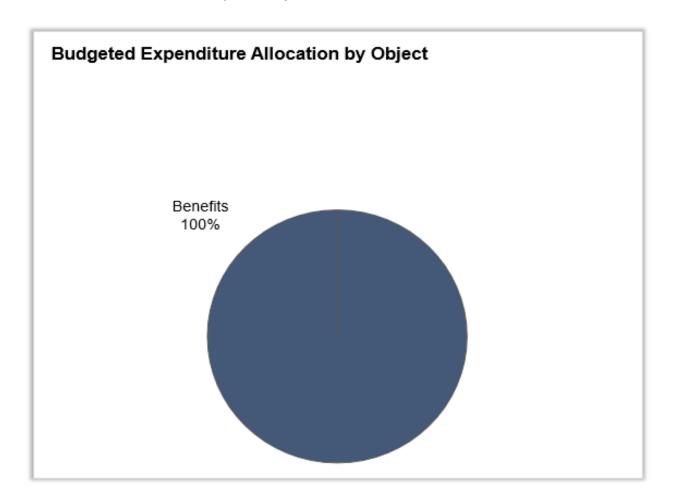

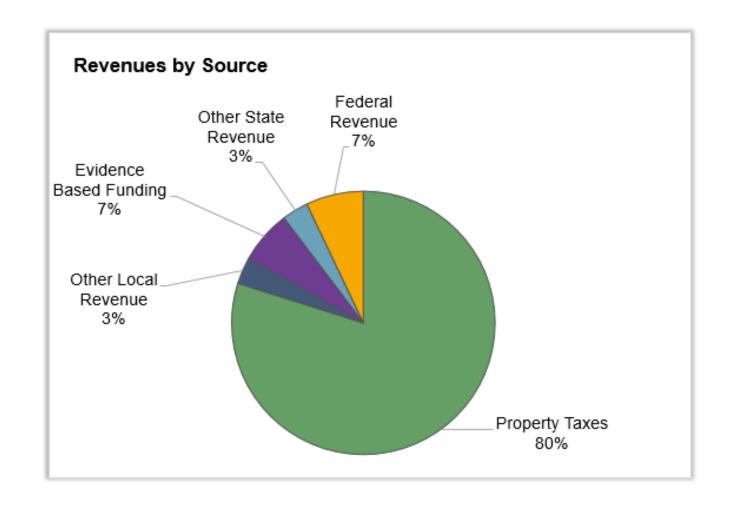

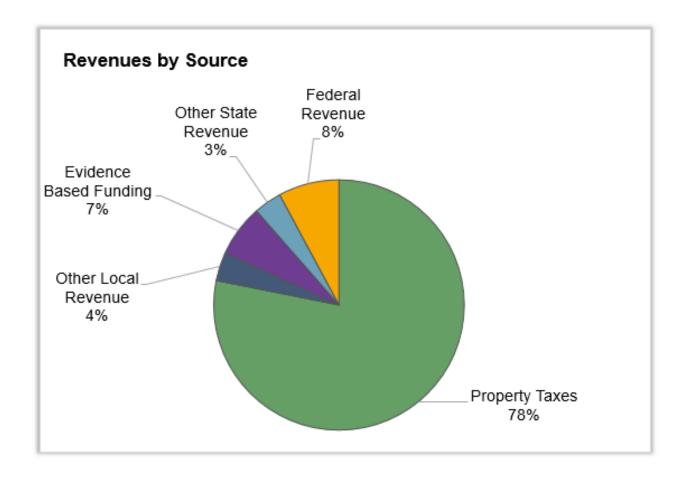

Revenue by Source - Operating Funds



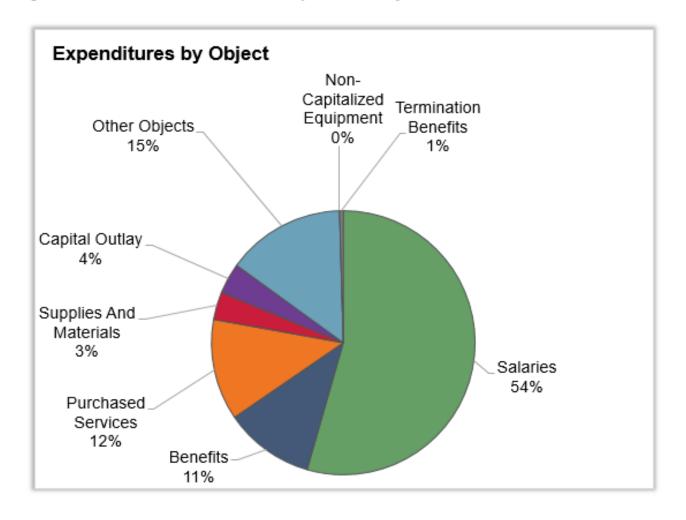

Expenditures by Object - All Funds





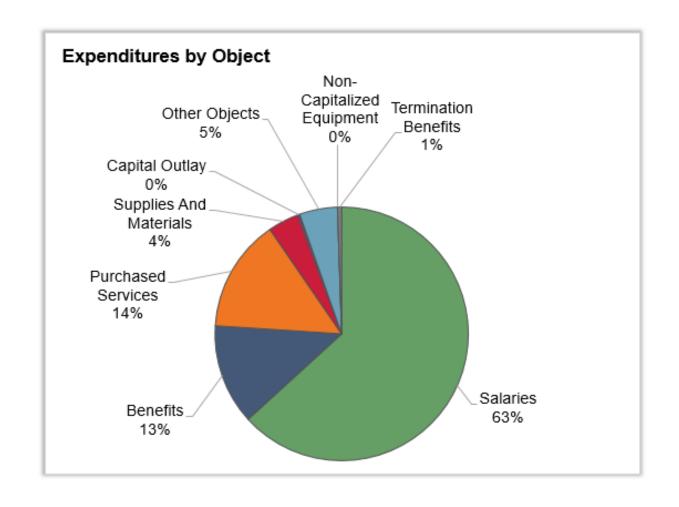

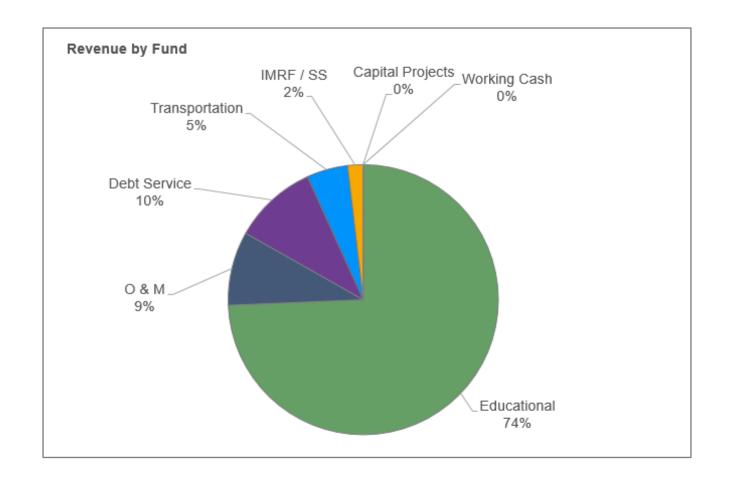

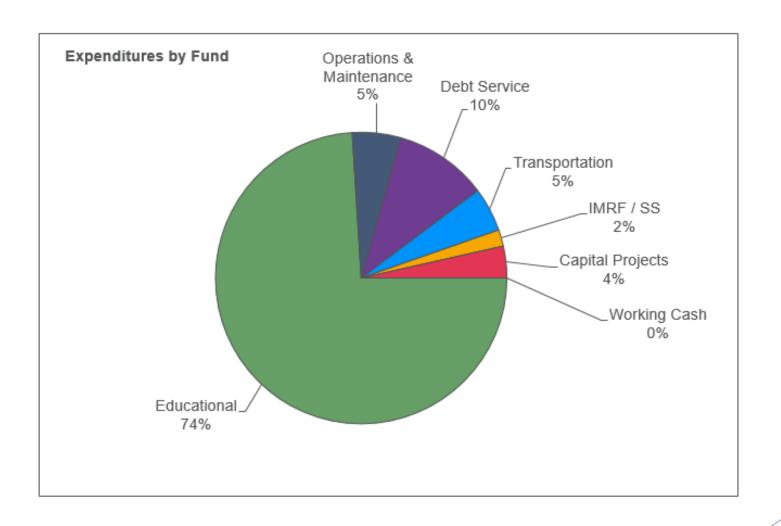
