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STABILITY AND SECURITY

- INSTALL NEW SWITCHES AND ACCESS POINTS FOR BETTER CONNECTIVITY DISTRICT WIDE
 - Fully complete infrastructure is modernized and now is on a predictable replacement cycle
 - ICN provide internet bandwidth increase from 3 GB to 10
 GB



STABILITY AND SECURITY

- INCREASE DISTRICT CYBERSECURITY MEASURES BY DEVELOPING A RELIABLE GUEST NETWORK FOR BYOD DEVICES
 - Network segmentation work completed per recommendation from our penetration test
- OTHER PHYSICAL SECURITY CHECKS
 - Informacast[™] operational in all district buildings
 - District admin receive mobile notifications and audio clips of any x1400 all-call message



STABILITY AND SECURITY

- OTHER ANNUAL SECURITY CHECKS
 - 2 factor authentication required for all critical district systems
 - 16 character passphrases required for district login
 - Annual phishing campaigns for district staff education



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COMPREHENSIVE DATA SYSTEMS

- ASSESS AREAS OF NEED FOR INNOVATION AND RELIABILITY IN DISTRICT SIS
 - Edupoint is now our direct support for troubleshooting any issue with Synergy
 - Edupoint will soon be directly supporting CUSD200 in maintaining and patching software as needed
 - CUSD200 is investigating having Edupoint store our database of information via cloud storage



COMPREHENSIVE DATA SYSTEMS

- ASSESS AREAS OF NEED FOR INNOVATION AND RELIABILITY IN DISTRICT HR and business system
 - Identified and started the process of Tyler Technologies host our database of information via cloud storage
 - Future proof iVisions software as new features are released
 - Faster support
 - Future projects likely to include streamlining workflow for onboarding new staff

COMPREHENSIVE DATA SYSTEMS

- HIRE INFORMATION SYSTEMS SPECIALIST TO SUPPORT BUSINESS AND HR DEPARTMENTS
 - Sam Reynolds, previously a IT Support Technician hired for role to oversee iVisions as well as to assist with Synergy support as needed.



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SOPPA Compliance - Phase 1

- All district 200 digital tools are monitored for student data and privacy requirements
- Learn Platform is the central hub teachers use to check which tools are allowed
- Learn Platform has a public facing site that parents can see which tools are allowed as well
- Phase 2 while a tool may be SOPPA compliant we need to ensure it can also be fully supported with district resources
