ALICE Retraining

- August 12, 2022 New Hires Trained in ALICE
- September 23, 2022 Middle Schools re-trained
- November 7, 2022 High Schools re-trained
- January 9, 2023 Elementary Schools re-trained
- Suggested to re-train ALICE protocols every 3-4 years






Homeland Security Training at at the Robert J. Miller Memorial Building
